September 1

We are children through new life in Christ; we are sons by adoption.

Romans 8:15b '...but you have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.'

Adoption is the Greek word 'huiothesia' which come from two Greek words 'huios' meaning 'son' and 'thesis' meaning 'to set in place'.

Adoption refers to our standing in Christ.

We are children through new life in Christ; we are sons by adoption.

We have not only received life in Christ,
we have been given the right of inheritance.

We are heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ.

Our relationship with God is more than a forgiven sinner;
we are sons and daughters of the living God.

In Christ we have been lifted from the depths of our sin to the heights of royalty.

September 2

Christ is the treasure who dwells in earthen vessels.

2 Corinthians 4:7 'But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellence of the power may be of God, and not of us.'

Christ is the treasure who dwells in earthen vessels.

His power moves mightily through our inability.

His strength upholds us in our weakness.

September 3

The greatest love.

but because of who He is.

September 4

Galatians 2:20 'I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ lives in me:'

September 5

September 6

An abundant entrance.

2 Peter 1:11 'For so an entrance shall be ministered unto you abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.'

How we live does not determine our eternal destiny;
we are saved by faith in Jesus Christ alone.
But how we live does reflect the extent of our love for Christ.
An abundant entrance into heaven
is the prize of all who love the Lord Jesus Christ.

September 7

September 8

September 10

Looking unto Jesus.

Hebrews 12:2 'Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.'

The Greek word 'aphoran' is translated in this verse as 'looking'.
It literally means 'to look away from'.
It is only when we look away from the pleasures of sin
and turn away from the pull of self centred lusts
that we can focus our attention upon Jesus.
He is the initiator and the completer of our faith.
His love for us joyfully gave all to save us.
He unites us with His life
so that we can joyfully live our life for Him.

September 11

Fellowship in the gospel.

Philippians 1:5 'For your fellowship in the gospel from the first day until now;'

Fellowship in the body of Christ involves everyday issues.
The believers had fervent love for one another;
they knew they were the disciples of Christ.
They were one family in Christ;

united by the life of Christ dwelling in them.
They were one team working together;
they had a responsibility
to be involved in spreading the message of the gospel.

September 12

True Christianity.

Colossians 1:27 'To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.'

True Christianity is not the way we dress or wear our hair;
it is not the music we listen to or the food we eat;
it is not keeping rules and laws;
it is the life of Christ in us.
It is who we are and not what we do
that determines whether or not we are in Christ.
Religion cannot produce new life;
the Church has no power to save.
New life in Christ is freely given through faith in Christ alone.
When Christ lives in us then His life will be seen
in our attitude, our words; and in everything we do.

September 13

One body in Christ, ministering together.

1 Corinthians 12:7 'But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal.'

The word profit is the Greek word 'sumphero'
which literally means to 'carry together'.
We are one body in Christ, called to build one another up in Christ.
We have different roles to fulfil,
but when Christ is our life then we are one in Him.
We are not clergy and laity. All believers are priests unto God.
We minister Christ together:
His life; His word; and His power work in us equipping us for ministry.
Together we grow in Christ offering as priests
a heart filled with thanksgiving and praise;
a life filled with love for the Lord Jesus Christ;
and a mind set to obey His word and to walk in His ways.

September 14

The beauty of Jesus in the eyes of a worshipper.

Song of Solomon 5:16 'His mouth is most sweet: yes, he is altogether lovely. This is my beloved, and this is my friend, O daughters of Jerusalem.'

Song of Solomon is written for worshippers.
It expresses our love for the Lord Jesus Christ.
His words bring joy and gladness.
The sweetness of His mouth is only known by those who walk in His truth.
His loveliness is beyond comparison.
He loved us when we were lost and without hope.
He looked beyond our unworthiness;
took away our unrighteousness;
removed our condemnation;
and clothed us in the garment of His righteousness.
He is more than our Saviour;
He is our Beloved.
He loved us so that we can love Him.
What a wonderful Friend we have in Jesus.

September 15

A living sacrifice.

Romans 12:1 'I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.'

The only response we can rightly make is to worship with our life.
We can do nothing to earn His favour.

September 17

September 19

True worship.

John 4:23-24 'But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in spirit and in truth.'

New Testament worship is not led by musicians.
We worship with our life and not just with our lips.
Worship is a lifestyle involving every area of our life.
True worship requires obedience to His word;
the love of Christ dwelling in us;
and the joy of the Holy Spirit filling our hearts.
The Holy Spirit will lead us higher in worship
as we grow in Christ and desire to know Him more.

September 20

Effectual prayer comes out of worship in the Holy Spirit.

Acts 4:31 'And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the word of God with boldness.'

Effectual prayer comes out of worship in the Holy Spirit.
We will see prayer answered to the extent that we worship.
It can be hard to get believers to come to prayer meetings.
Sometimes people attend prayer meetings regularly
but their commitment is in attending the prayer meeting.
God will not move just because we are committed to the prayer meeting.
We need to worship through prayer.
When our prayer meeting is the place of worshipful prayer in the Holy Spirit
then we will see God move in mighty power on behalf of His people.

September 21

The world will only see the kingdom of God through our lives.

John 3:3 'Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.'

The world will only see the kingdom of God through our lives.
We are the evidence of the kingdom of God.
The gospel must be preached by our words; seen by our lives;
and confirmed in the hearts and minds of others by the Holy Spirit.
When self sits enthroned in our life
then the kingdom of this world is seen.
When Christ reigns as Lord then righteousness; peace; and joy will be seen.
The world cannot see the kingdom of God
but it can recognize the power of God working in the lives of His people.

September 22

The whole counsel of God is always double-edged.

Acts 20:27 'For I have not held back to make known unto you all the counsel of God.'

The whole counsel of God is always double-edged.
The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ will lead us into His truth.
If we have no love for the word of God then we have not experienced the grace of God.
The mercy of God will lead us from sin to righteousness.
If we have no desire to live a righteous life
then it is because we have not received the mercy of God.
The love of God will never deny the justice of God.
We can only become the recipients of the love of God
by receiving the free gift of justification through faith in Jesus Christ alone.

September 23

Christ must be our life; our passion, our joy, and our message.

Acts 5:42 'And daily in the temple, and in every house, they ceased not to teach and preach Jesus Christ.'

The church in the book of Acts preached Christ.
The believers were filled with His life;
endued with His power;
walked in His love;
and gave themselves to His word.
They held truth to be more important
than the need for acceptance or recognition.
They were filled with joy and excitement.
They eagerly told others about Jesus because they had experienced Him.
They preached because they had a message that brought life to whosoever believes.
Christ was their life; their passion, their joy, and their message.
The world will see that Jesus is alive when the same passion can also be seen in us.

September 24

Our faith must be activated by repentance.

James 2:19, 'You believe that there is one God; you do well: the devils also believe, and tremble.'
Salvation is more than believing something to be true.

The Bible says that even the devils believe.
The devils tremble with extreme fear
because they know they are a defeated enemy;
their judgment is certain; and their destruction is near.
If we believe in Christ but never activate our faith
then our faith is useless.
If we truly trust in Christ

then our faith must be activated by repentance.
An activated faith turns from sin to Christ.
An active faith trusts in all that Christ has done for us
and rests in His provision for us.
The evidence of saving faith is new life in Christ.

September 25

Life and godliness.

2 Peter 1:3 'According as His divine power has given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who has called us to glory and virtue:'

Godliness is the outworking of the life of Christ in us.
It refers to a life that is godly in character.
It is never legalistic
nor does it ever wear the clothing of religion.
It is the freedom of new life in Christ;
it is a life that worships through our everyday life;
it is a heart filled with the love of Christ
reaching out to a world that needs Jesus.
We cannot live a godly life in our own strength.
Jesus came for this purpose so that His life can be in us.

September 26

Freedom from the need to elevate self.

Philippians 2:3 'Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory;'

If we are motivated by selfish ambition; personal gain;
or by the need for status and respect
then we will be no different from the world.
In Christ we are free to have a completely
different perspective from the world.
We have no need to elevate ourselves
because Christ is our life.
We do not need to seek the riches of the world
because Christ is our provision.
We do not need the praise and admiration of the world
because Christ is our inheritance.
We have no need to push others down in a competitive world
because Christ has lifted us.
He fills us with His love
so that we can be His people in a self-seeking world.

September 27

Guarding ourselves from the intoxication of the world.

1 Thessalonians 5:8 'But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for a helmet, the hope of salvation.'

We must guard our heart and mind from the intoxication of the world.
The hopes of the world will fade;
the desire for worldly gain will never satisfy;
and the pleasures of the world will bring no lasting joy.
But in Jesus Christ our hope is certain.
He will satisfy and fill the longing heart.
The joy He gives will never pass away.
His word will never fail;
His love will never cease;
and His kingdom will never end.
All who trust in Him will never be disappointed.
It is His love in us that removes all fear.

September 28

Fishermen must go where the fish are.

Mark 1:17 'And Jesus said unto them, Come after Me, and I will make you to become fishers of men.'

Fishermen must go where the fish are.
They must use the right methods to catch the fish.
They must leave the comforts of home and sail far out into the sea.
They must face stormy weather;
they need to work through the night;
they must endure hardship;
they must encounter danger and in some cases risk their own lives
in order to fill the nets with fish.
The world needs the gospel;
fishermen and women are needed
to bring in those who will receive Jesus.
If we stay in our comfort zone then how will the world ever hear
the good news of salvation in Jesus Christ?

September 29

Taking care so that we will not be ashamed on the day Jesus returns.

2 Peter 3:17 'You therefore, beloved, seeing you know these things before, beware lest you also, being led away with the error of the wicked, fall from your own steadfastness.'

We know Jesus will return.
We know because Christ lives in us.
We know His word is true
because we have experienced His power working in our life.
The Spirit of God has been given to us
as the down payment on our full inheritance in Christ.

It is He who bears witness within us that we are the children of God.
The reasoning of the world will seek
to turn our heart away from the truth of the gospel.
We need always to take care
so that we will not be ashamed on the day Jesus returns.

September 30

It is our responsibility to grow in grace.

2 Peter 3:18 'But grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. To Him be glory both now and forever. Amen.'
